As an exercise, I'd like you to take pencil to paper and do a rough sketch of a plan of your own. Look to the use of space and how to incorporate the important living space features that accommodate sleeping, washroom, lounge/eating, food prep and storage.

Take a photo of your sketch and include it with your response. If we can get a few examples, we can then start a discussion on what would be needed to build one of the submitted plans. Try to keep the square footage to 300 square feet (about 10m<sup>2</sup>) or less.
