

**Grade 9 Social Studies
Cross Canada Travel Project**

Your assignment is to plan a trip across Canada. Your starting will be Charlottetown and you must visit all 10 provinces within three weeks (21 days). This can be done on word, paper, Bristol board, power point, etc.

You must adhere to the following guidelines:

1. You must stay at least one night in each provincial capital and you must indicate where you stay.

2. You must visit at least three different communities (towns, villages, cities) within each province and provide a brief description of each. You must include information on:
 - a. population
 - b. history
 - c. climate
 - d. recreation opportunities
 - e. attractions
 - f. festivals/events
 - g. land features
 - h. universities/colleges
 - i. culturally significant foods

3. You must visit three provincially/nationally recognized historic sites and five tourist attractions. Provide descriptions of each.

4. You must attend two cultural events and two sporting events over the duration of your trip. Describe the events.

5. You must provide an overall budget of all trip expenses. This includes everything from gas, food, hotels, cost of tourist attractions, historic sites, sporting events, tolls etc.

6. For attractions, events, etc. make sure you indicate a rough time frame for the completion of each task.

7. Keep a planner/ detailed itinerary of your DAILY activities. It may be easier to think this through prior to beginning the actual presentation. You must include distances travelled each day.

8. Remember to include any graphics, illustrations, photos etc. that will strengthen your project.

All facts and figures must be accurate and able to be verified so you will have to back this up with research. You cannot make up fake amounts for meals, etc.

Tip: Research will be the key to this assignment if you are to be successful
