Independent Novel Study Assignment

(this assignment will be for the next three weeks so you will have time to read and complete a novel)

A) Character Analysis

Choose the main character in your novel and then ...

Choose 3 of the following to complete with examples from the novel.

Appearance / personality traits

Reactions of others to the character.

Why is s/he important to the plot of the novel?

Would you like to be the main character? Why or why not?

Would you like the main character as a friend? Give reasons.

NOTE: your character sketch should be about 250 words in length.

B) Plot

Write a short plot-summary of your chosen novel (250 words). Include information such as where and when the story happens, who is telling the story and whether or not you enjoyed the plot and your reasons. What is the significance of the novel title to the the book? (Remember to include the 5 parts of plot). See below for example of Plot
