

Land and Water Use – How has it changed over time?

Outcomes:

- describe how land and water use in New Brunswick has changed over the last 300 years.
- explore how the development of technologies has affected land and water use.

For the next two weeks, we are focusing on how things have changed over time. We heard last week in the documentary how the ways we use the land and water has changed quite a bit. To reinforce that, you will research either land or water use, using the following items to help guide your research:

Land Use	Water Use
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pre-industrial• Industrial revolution• Land use/land cover change• Ownership of land	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Agriculture (and modernization)• Lakes/marshes, oceans, rivers, etc.• Freshwater• Travel• Indoor/outdoor use

Make sure to thoroughly research the topic you chose (water or land use).

- Put everything into your own words.
- Cite your sources if you are quoting an article (even in writing your research)
- Include a bibliography

Once you have finished your research, you can choose to send it to me any way you choose.

Here are some options:

- 1) Create a timeline (on paper). Include color and details. Make sure it is neat. Send me a photo of it.
- 2) Create a piece of artwork (with explanations) showing water and land use back during a certain time, verses land and water use today. Send me a photo of it.
- 3) Create a poster showing your research for both land and water use.
- 4) Create a PowerPoint with your research.
- 5) Your choice
