

WWI in Cartoons

In this assignment, you will explore political cartoons about WWI—to explore how people's attitudes changed about the war.

The first cartoon is from prewar (1913), the second at the beginning of WW1 (1914) and the third is from 1916 (the midpoint of the war)

Questions

1. What did each political cartoonist try to convey about WWI to their audience?
- 2.. How do these cartoons differ in tone?
3. What symbols and choices did these cartoonists use to get their messages across? Identify and explain at least one symbol from each cartoon.
4. What's changed between 1913, to 1916, to produce very different cartoons?
